'Service Before Self' - XI-S's Assembly Celebrates Kargil Vijay Diwas Fri, 26 July 2024



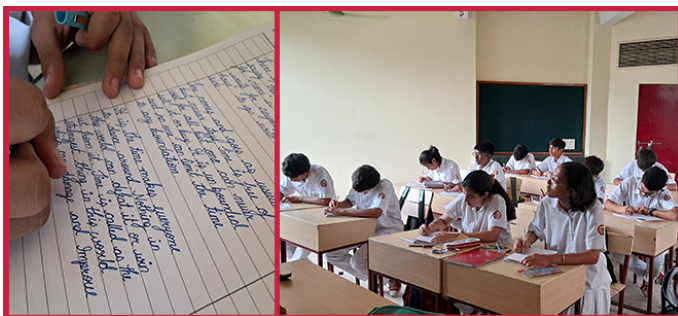

The Sagar School's Ahmedabad Art Tour Sparks Creativity Mon, 29 July 2024



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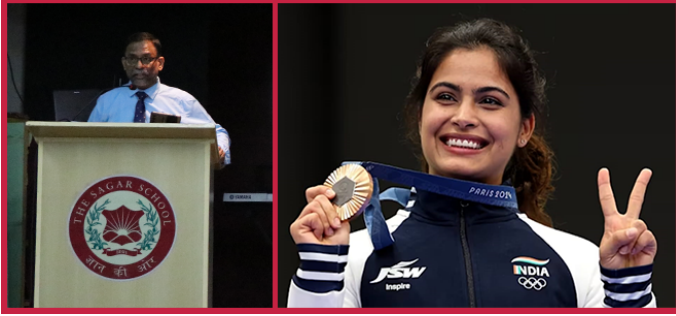
