Important Points for Sample Question Papers

The following points are to be noted while studying/referring to the Sample Papers for Classes X & XII Term 1 for the academic session 2021-22:

- The Multiple Choice Questions given in the sample papers are not of one mark each for all papers.
- 2. In the SQPs of Mathematics and all languages except English, each question carries one mark.
- 3. For other subjects, each question carries equal marks viz.-a-viz. the total marks given i.e. 40 or 35or 25 or 15 and the weight age of marks per question will be as follows:-

40	50	0.80
35	50	0.70
40	45	0.88
35	45	0.77
25	40	0.625
15	25	0.60
